Solid Waste Monitor

- Rural Container Sites, Landfill and Transfer Station
- 40-hour Week, Union position
- Hours/days will vary, weekends required

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Landfill & Transfer Station Monitoring

- Checks wastes entering the facility for unacceptable materials
- Records volumes/types of wastes entering
- Directs traffic to waste disposal areas
- Issues surcharges for uncontrolled loads
- Operates communication system
 - Telephone, Computers, 2-way radio, etc.
- Cleans and maintains appearance of sites
- Picks up Litter
- Performs other duties as required

Container Site Monitoring

- Visits rural container sites to educate public and enforce waste disposal policies
- Keeps container site free of litter
- Cleans and maintains appearance of sites
- Assists Drivers as necessary
- Issues surcharges for uncontrolled loads
- Keeps record of site visitors
- Performs other duties as required

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Valid Montana driver's license and safe driving record
 - Allow a review of the Motor Vehicle Operator's Record
- Ability to work well with public and co-workers
- Some computer skills required
- Ability to keep detailed records
- Able to obtain insurance under Lake County's auto liability policy
