

Proposed Amendment to Lake County Floodplain Regulations

Proposed text to be added:

5.06 Floodplains within the Lake and Lakeshore Protection Zone

Those properties and projects that also fall under the jurisdiction of the Lake County Lakeshore Protection Regulations shall not have to obtain a Lake County Floodplain Development Permit for the following proposed activity or activities that the Lake County Floodplain Administrator finds shall have an insignificant impact on the floodplain:

- Open and Floating Docks (those that do not impede the flow of water beneath the dock; this does not include crib docks or other solid or partially open docks),
- Boat Shelters and Boat Lifts/Shore Stations,
- Buoys,
- Other small scale projects that have an insignificant impact on the floodplain

***Note:** On Tuesday, April 12, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners' office in the Lake County Courthouse, the Board of Lake County Commissioners will hold a public hearing to review the proposed amendment to the Lake County Floodplain Regulations (as shown above). The public is invited to attend the public hearing and voice comments on the proposal.
